of several ethnic groups it provides insights into numerous societal relationships to weddings such as the ban on bridal produced embroidery in dowries in india the challenges individual values have to larger societal ones in themed weddings and the relationship between the return to pre western attire and identity politics exploring these issues the authors provide unusual insights into the centrality of dress in shaping individual identity as well as its importance in reflecting cultural values and ideals
